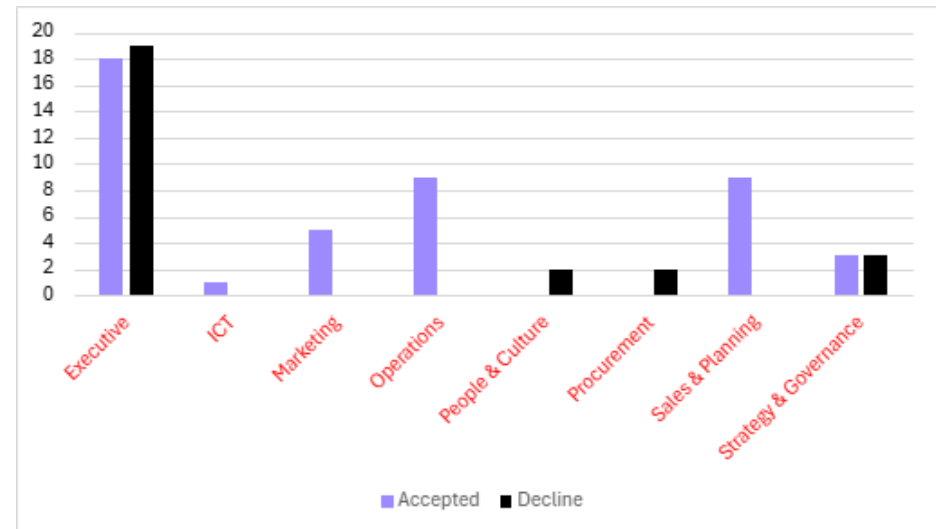

Commentary

In 2024-25, a total of 71 entries were recorded, compared to 55 in 2023-24, representing a **29.1%** increase in volume. Regarding the distribution of decisions:

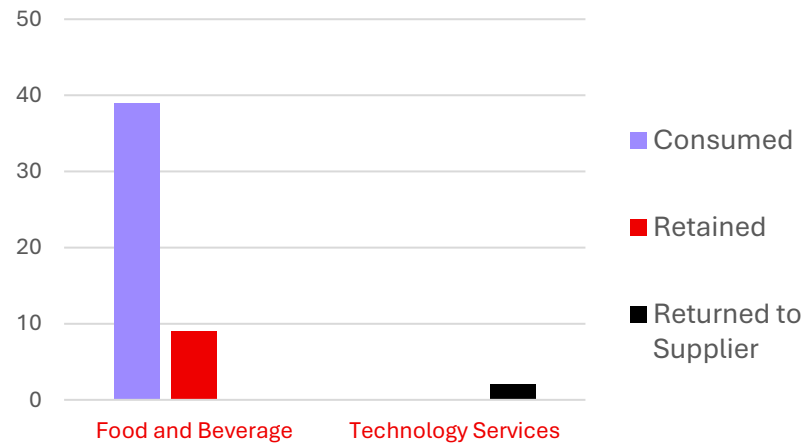
- In 2023-24, 56.4% of entries were accepted and 43.6% were declined.
- In 2024-25, 63.4% were accepted and 36.6% declined.

This reflects a variation of +7 percentage points in the acceptance rate and -7 points in the declination rate compared to the previous year.

The most cited Policy Justification among accepted offers in 2024-2025 was networking, indicating a continued trend of relying on this rationale. VCET's compliance registers have recently been updated to require more rigour in the rationale provided.

Additionally, a shift was observed in the organisations making repeat offers. Compared to the previous year, the most frequent offerors were primarily industry partners rather than prospective clients or suppliers, suggesting a strengthening of corporate alliances.
